Chapter I. General Provisions

Article 1. Purpose of the document

The purpose of this document is to ensure academic integrity at the Georgian American University, LLC and to introduce appropriate mechanisms.

Article 2. Definition of terms

- 1. Academic Dishonesty For the purposes of this policy, academic dishonesty means gaining an academic achievement (advantage) for oneself or for another (including academic evaluation, publication) in a dishonest and unfair manner;
- 2. Plagiarism For the purposes of this policy, plagiarism means presenting someone else's work or idea (s) as your own work without reference to the author. The paper refers to both published and unpublished material (book, article, lecture, thesis, student essay, project, etc.), both in manuscript as well as in printed or electronic form. The material can be text as well as video-audio files, illustrations, graphs, etc.

Article 3. Academic dishonesty

- ✓ Academic dishonesty includes the following actions:
- ✓ Plagiarism;
- ✓ Data falsification;
- ✓ Involvement of another person (including a student) in the merit of academic achievement;
- ✓ Use of prohibited material during the assessment, such as textbook, syllabus, calculator, telephone (smartphone), etc.;
- ✓ Attempting to copy from another student during the assessment;
- ✓ Cheating;
- ✓ Stealing, destroying or altering someone else's work;
- ✓ Obtaining confidential information / materials to complete the task;
- ✓ Etc.

Chapter II. Plagiarism

Article 4. Types of plagiarism

- 1. Intentional / direct plagiarism plagiarism, when a person knows and understands the essence of plagiarism, but nevertheless deliberately breaks the rules in order to gain benefit (score, academic degree, recognition and / or material benefit) and advantage;
- 2. Careless / negligent plagiarism plagiarism, when a person is well acquainted with the essence of plagiarism, but, nevertheless, pays less attention to the observance of the relevant rules and in some cases does not care about the observance of these rules;
- 3. Accidental / indirect plagiarism plagiarism, when a person does not know what plagiarism is, and therefore does not realize the need to cite the author, acknowledge his merits, does not know that a similar work was done by someone else and / or accidentally missed the author.

Article 5. Forms of plagiarism

- 1. Complete plagiarism submitting someone else's work as your own work. Using the various ways of obtaining this work: buying intellectual property from the author and / or the agency, both with and without their permission; Having a lecturer, colleague, friend, relative and/or a person close to you complete the work for you;
- 2. "Clone" a work in which someone else's text is used verbatim and is presented as one's own;
- 3. "CTRL-C" a paper in which important parts of the text are transferred from one source without changes;
- 4. "CTRL-F" a paper where keywords and phrases are changed, but the essential content of the source is retained;
- 5. "Re-ranking" a paper where paraphrases made from multiple sources are adapted to each other;
- 6. "Recycling" a work in which a large part of the author's previous work is used without citation;
- 7. "Hybrid" a paper in which perfectly cited sources are combined with excerpts downloaded without citation;
- 8. "Mosaic" a work where material downloaded from many sources is mixed;
- 9. "404 Error" the paper includes a citation containing non-existent or incorrect information about the sources;

- 10. "RSS Feed" a work in which the sources are properly indicated, but contains almost no original work;
- 11. "Reprint" a paper in which the source is properly indicated, but very close to the original text and / or structure;
- 12. "Collusion" another person (s) is involved in the development of the work, in violation of the guidelines and rules of the work, the work does not indicate part of the work done by this person (s);
- 13. Self plagiarism use of one's own work without reference to another work, submission of the same work at the same time for different benefits and / or use of one's own work to reevaluate an already evaluated work;
- 14. Translation translation of someone else's work without reference to sources;
- 15. Failure to acknowledge assistance the paper does not mention or acknowledge such assistance (idea, opinion, etc.) that contributed significantly to the performance of the paper;
- 16. Plagiarism of an idea conveying another's idea without the author's reference;
- 17. Style plagiarism following in the footsteps of an opinion expressed in a source, using the author's writing style in their own work, even if the sentences are substantially different.

Article 6. Prevention of plagiarism

- 1. The purpose of avoiding and preventing plagiarism is to conduct research on the advanced scientific research achievements within the institution in accordance with the principle of academic integrity.
- 2. To prevent plagiarism, the University undertakes to develop academic writing skills at all three levels of study. Academic writing skills can be developed in educational programs through both independent academic writing courses and written assignments given within existing training courses;
- 3. In order to prevent plagiarism, it is mandatory to include in the components provided by the academic-educational programs implemented by the University the criteria for assignments and evaluation criteria, which will develop the student's ability to analyze someone else's work and form independent, reasoned conclusions;
- 4. To prevent plagiarism, the University provides the following support services:
 - a. Electronic textbooks;
 - b. Regular consultations for interested parties;
 - c. Instant response to violations by the administration.

Chapter III. Identifying academic dishonesty and plagiarism

Article 7. Revealing the fact of academic dishonesty and plagiarism

- 1. The fact of academic dishonesty and plagiarism can be revealed by any interested person scientific supervisor, reviewer, administration employee, representative of the examination center, relevant person involved in the academic process.
- 2. The mechanism of the software "Strikeplagiarism.com" is used to detect plagiarism in the University. It is used to check the originality of the paper. "Strikeplagiarism.com" compares the text of the paper with the information in the program databases and shows the percentage of consistency. The program does not determine plagiarism, it is only an auxiliary tool.
- 3. In case of detection of plagiarism by the electronic anti-plagiarism program, by the decision of the School Dean, the paper is submitted for conclusion to the scientific / research paper evaluation commission of the School.
- 4. After awarding the qualification (at the Master's and Doctoral level), the issue of cancellation of the qualification shall be considered when determining the fact of plagiarism.

Article 8. The procedure for checking the plagiarism of the paper in the electronic program

- 1. The computer web platform "Strikeplagiarism.com" program (hereinafter the Program) is used in detail in "The rule of checking for the existence of plagiarism of the executed work" at the Georgian American University, LLC.
- 2. The following works are checked through the program "Strikeplagiarism.com":
 - a. Materials submitted for publication on behalf of the University (articles, monographs, textbooks, etc.);
 - b. Materials to be presented at the international / local conference on behalf of the University;
 - c. Doctoral student seminar paper;
 - d. Master thesis:
 - e. Bachelor Thesis;
 - f. In some cases, if the program and / or the syllabus of the training course will indicate this, the project / assignment completed within the training course.

Article 9. Commission for evaluation of school scientific / research work

- 1. The school scientific / research paper evaluation commission is established on the basis of the order of the school dean.
- 2. The Scientific / Research Paper Evaluation Commission consists of:
 - a. Dean of the School;
 - b. School / University Quality Assurance Office Representative;
 - c. Director / Directors of the School Research Center (Institute);
 - d. Head / supervisors of the educational program;
 - e. Two School Professors / Associate Professors.
- 3. Considering the purpose of the Scientific / Research Paper Evaluation Commission, as well as the content and specifics of the research topics, experts
- 4. (s) in the field may be invited to the work of the Commission.
- 5. A scientific / research paper on public defense, for publication or at a later stage of evaluation shall be allowed only in case of a positive conclusion of the Research Component Development Commission.

Chapter IV. Responsibility for exposing academic dishonesty and plagiarism

Article 10 Sanctions for committing an act of academic dishonesty

The following sanctions may be applied when a student commits an act of academic dishonesty:

- ✓ In case of falsification of data, the case is transferred to a disciplinary body;
- ✓ In case of involvement of another person in the merit of the academic achievement by the student, the issue is transferred to the disciplinary body;
- ✓ In case of using prohibited material during the assessment, the paper is canceled without further restoration of the task and a verbal warning is given. Repeating this action cancels the paper without further reinstatement of the assignment and gives written warning to the student by the School administration;
- ✓ During the attempt to copy from another student during the assessment, the paper is canceled, without further restoration of the assignment, and a verbal warning is given. Repeating this action cancels the

- ✓ paper without further reinstatement of the assignment and gives written warning to the student by the School administration;
- ✓ Stealing, destroying and altering someone else's work leads to the transfer of the matter to a disciplinary body;
- ✓ In case of stealing confidential information / material to complete the task, the issue will be referred to the disciplinary body.

Article 11. Sanctions for committing acts of complete plagiarism

- 1. In case of complete plagiarism in the Undergraduate program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the issue is referred to the disciplinary body.
- 2. In case of complete plagiarism in the Master's degree, the training course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be transferred to the disciplinary body.
- 3. In case of complete plagiarism in the Doctoral program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be submitted to the Dissertation Board.

Article 12. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact of "clone"

- 1. In case of finding out the fact of "clone" in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the issue is referred to the disciplinary body.
- 2. In case of finding out the fact of "clone" in the Master's degree, the training course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be transferred to the disciplinary body.
- 3. In case of establishing the fact of "clone" in the Doctoral program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be submitted to the Dissertation Board.

Article 13. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact "CTRL-C"

- 1. In the event of a targeted CTRL-C finding in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment, and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.
- 2. In case of negligent CTRL-C in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.
- 3. In case of finding a random "CTRL-C" fact in the Bachelor's degree, the student will be given additional assignment and verbal warning. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.
- 4. In case of finding the fact of targeted "CTRL-C" in the Master's degree, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstatement of the assignment and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be referred to the disciplinary body.
- 5. In case of negligence of CTRL-C in the Master's program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstatement of the assignment. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.
- 6. In case of finding a random "CTRL-C" fact in the master's degree, the student will be given additional assignment and verbal warning. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.
- 7. In case of establishing the fact "CTRL-C" in any form in the Doctoral program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be transferred to the Dissertation Board.

Article 14. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact "CTRL-F"

1. If the "CTRL-F" targeted fact is found in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.

- 2. In case of negligent "CTRL-F" in the undergraduate course, the course
- 3. / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstatement of the assignment. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.
- 4. In case of accidental "CTRL-F" in the Undergraduate student, the student will be given additional assignment and oral warning. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.
- 5. If the CTRL-F targeted fact in the Master's degree is established, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be referred to the disciplinary body.
- 6. In case of negligence of CTRL-F in the Master's degree, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstatement of the assignment. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.
- 7. In case of finding a random "CTRL-F" fact in the Master's degree, the student will be given additional assignment and oral warning. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.
- 8. In case of establishing the fact "CTRL-F" in any form in the Doctoral program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be transferred to the Dissertation Board.

Article 15. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact of "re-ranking"

- 1. If the fact of intentional "re-ranking" in the Bachelor's degree is established, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.
- 2. In case of negligent "re-ranking" in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstatement of the assignment. In case of repeated actions, the course
- 3. / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.

- 4. In case of accidental "re-ranking" in the Undergraduate program, the student will be given additional assignment and verbal warning. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.
- 5. If the fact of targeted "re-ranking" in the Master's degree is established, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstatement of the assignment and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be referred to the disciplinary body.
- 6. In case of negligent "re-ranking" in the Master's program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstatement of the assignment. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.
- 7. In case of accidental "re-ranking" in the Master's degree, the student will be given additional assignment and oral warning. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.
- 8. In case of establishing the fact of "re-ranking" in any form in the Doctoral program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be submitted to the Dissertation Board.

Article 16. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact of "recycling"

- 1. In case of intentional "processing" in the Undergraduate program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, without the right to further resume the assignment, and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the issue is referred to the disciplinary body.
- 2. In case of negligent "processing" in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a warning. In case of repeated actions, the issue is referred to the disciplinary body.
- 3. In case of accidental "processing" in the Bachelor's degree, the paper will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstate the assignment and the student will be given an additional assignment. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with

- 4. zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.
- 5. If the fact of intentional "processing" in the Master's degree is established, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, without the right to further resume the assignment, and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the issue is referred to the disciplinary body.
- 6. In case of negligent "processing" in the Master's degree, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further resume the assignment and the student will be given a warning. In case of repeated actions, the issue is referred to the disciplinary body.
- 7. In case of finding out the fact of accidental "processing" in the Master's thesis, the paper will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further recover of the assignment and the student will be given an additional assignment. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.
- 8. In case of any fact of "processing" in the Doctoral program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be referred to the Dissertation Board.

Article 17. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact of "hybrid"

- 1. In case of finding a fact of targeted "hybrid" in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, without the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the issue is referred to the disciplinary body.
- 2. In case of detection of negligent "hybrid" in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further resume of the assignment and the student will be given a warning. In case of repeated actions, the issue is referred to the disciplinary body.
- 3. In case of finding a fact of random "hybrid" in the Bachelor's degree, the paper will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstate the assignment and the student will be given an additional assignment. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.
- 4. In case of finding a fact of targeted "hybrid" in the Master's degree, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, without the right to further reinstate the assignment and the student will be given a written

- 8. In case of establishing the fact of "hybrid" in any form in the Doctoral program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be transferred to the Dissertation Board.

Article 18. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact of "mosaic"

In case of finding a fact of targeted "mosaic" in the Undergraduate program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstate the assignment and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.
- 2. In case of detection of negligent "mosaic" in the Undergraduate course,
- 3. the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstate the assignment. In case of repeated actions, the course
- 4. / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the student will be given a written warning.
- 5. In case of finding out the fact of random "mosaic" in the Bachelor's degree, the student will be given additional assignment and oral warning. In case of repetition of the action, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a written warning.

Article 19. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact of "404 Error"

- 1. In case of detection of plagiarism of "404 Error" intentionally in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstatement of the assignment and the student will be given a warning. If the action is repeated, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade and the student will be given a warning.
- 2. In case of detection of negligent 404 Error plagiarism in the Undergraduate course, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a warning. If the action is repeated, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade and the student will be given a warning.
- 3. In case of finding the fact of plagiarism of "404 Error" in the Undergraduate program, the student will be given additional assignment and warning. If the action is repeated, the student will be given an additional assignment and a written warning.
- 4. In case of finding the fact of plagiarism of "404 Error" targeted in the Master's degree, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a warning. If the action is repeated, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade and the student will be given a warning.
- 5. In case of plagiarism of negligent "404 Error" in the Master's degree, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to further reinstatement of the assignment and the student will be given a warning. If the action is repeated, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade and the student will be given a warning.
- 6. In case of finding the plagiarism of "404 Error" in the Master's degree, the student will be given additional assignment and warning. If the action is repeated, the student will be given an additional assignment and a written warning.

7. In case of detection of 404 Error plagiarism in any way in the Doctoral program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be referred to the Dissertation Board.

Article 20. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact of "RSS Feed"

- 1. In case of detection of plagiarism of targeted RSS Feed at the undergraduate level, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a warning. If the action is repeated, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade and the student will be given a warning.
- 2. In case of detection of negligent RSS Feed plagiarism in the undergraduate course, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a warning. If the action is repeated, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade and the student will be given a warning.
- 3. In case of detection of random "RSS Feed" plagiarism in the undergraduate program, the student will be given additional assignments and warnings. If the action is repeated, the student will be given an additional assignment and a written warning.
- 4. In case of plagiarism of the targeted RSS Feed in the master's degree, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a warning. If the action is repeated, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade and the student will be given a warning.
- 5. In case of detection of negligent RSS Feed plagiarism in the Master's program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, with the right to resume the assignment and the student will be given a warning. If the action is repeated, the course / research component will be assessed with zero grade and the student will be given a warning.
- 6. In case of finding the fact of plagiarism of random "RSS Feed" in the master's degree, the student will be given additional assignments and warnings. If the action is repeated, the student will be given an additional assignment and a written warning.
- 7. In case of detection of RSS Feed plagiarism in any way in the doctoral program, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade and the issue will be submitted to the Dissertation Board.

Article 21. Sanctions in case of establishing the fact of "re-publication"

- 1. If the fact of intentional "republishing" in the bachelor's degree is established, the course / research component will be evaluated with zero grade, without the right to resume the assignment, and the student will be given a written warning. In case of repeated actions, the issue is referred to the disciplinary body.
