



Priorities of Research Activities of Georgian American University, LLC

Introduction:

The submitted document has been prepared taking into account the University Mission, Strategic Development and Research Strategy Documents of Georgian American University, LLC (hereinafter: the University).

University Mission:

Provide knowledge based on the leading scientific-research and educational-practical models, conduct research and innovative activities.
